FREE OR NO-COST COVID-19 TESTING CENTERS

No-cost testing is available at local health centers and select pharmacies:

Health Resources & Services Administration

Can help you locate and find a health center near you that offers telehealth or COVID-19 Testing in your area.

Please call ahead to make an appointment.

RITE-AID

Covid-19 Testing Available at no cost for anyone 18+ years of age.

Complete a pre-screening and schedule anappointment at a Rite Aid location near you.

<u>Walgreens</u>

contactless COVID-19 testing at select locations in partnership with the PWNHealth provider network.*

Testing is available at no cost to eligible individuals who meet criteria established by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and state and federal guidelines.

At the testing locations, Walgreens pharmacy team oversees patients' self-administration of the COVID-19 test.

Take a quick screening survey to see if you're eligible for testing.

CVS Pharmacies/Minute Clinic

Appointments are available 7 days a week. \$0 out-of-pocket cost with insurance or federal program for uninsured.

Patients should not have any out-of-pocket costs, but you should check with your health plan to confirm before scheduling a test.

Lab Testing Results typically take 2-3 days. High demand at the labs can lead to delays in turnaround times.

<u>Local independent pharmacies</u> (eTrueNorth)

Testing locations use a self-administered nasal swab test that allows you to swab your own nose while in your vehicle, supervised by trained medical volunteers.

Results are delivered within 3-5 business days. You will receive an email notification when results are available. Once you receive the email, return to this site and logon to view and print your lab report.

If you receive an appointment, it is VERY IMPORTANT that you PRINT and bring your test voucher with you on the day of your test.

Look for emergency warning signs* of COVID-19.

If someone is showing any of these signs, seek emergency medical care immediately:

- Trouble breathing
- Persistent pain or pressure in the chest
- New confusion
- · Inability to wake or stay awake
- Bluish lips or face

*This list is not all possible symptoms. Please call your medical provider for any other symptoms that are severe or concerning to you.

Call 911 or call ahead to your local emergency facility: Notify the operator that you are seeking care for someone who has or may have COVID-19.
